We wash our hands first for PICKLE and then for PICKLE.

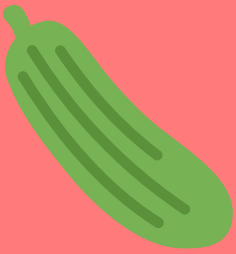
We break the middle PICKLE into two pieces.

dark.

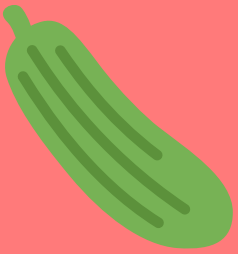
Hashem made PICKLE the first month for the
